2. 100% Irrevocable, Confirmable Documentary Letter of Credit (DLC) – MT700
3. Issued by a top-rated international bank
4. Performance Bond:

Procedures

- Buyer issues Letter of Intent (LOI) with company profile

- Both parties execute the Sales & Purchase Agreement (SPA)
- Buyer opens 100% DLC (MT700)
- Seller issues 2% Performance Bond
- Seller commences shipment based on the agreed schedule
- Buyer releases payment as per LC terms after successful SGS inspection at the destination
